

Social Prescribing is a non-medical, community intervention that improves the health and wellbeing of local residents via the VCFSE sector. Link Workers assess and support clients with a large variety of needs from health to housing, and from debt to welfare, and many other needs too.

In Pendle we are running a Social Prescribing for Children & Young People pilot programme covering the Pendle West Primary Care Network. These figures are displayed on the Health & Wellbeing for Children & Families page.


We continue to support children and young people through a pilot Social Prescribing project in the Pendle West PCN area.
