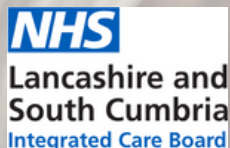

The service is reliant on volunteer drivers who use their own cars to transport passengers. The service helps the socially isolated, disabled and elderly get to groups, lunch clubs, trips into town, and much more.

The minibus is driven by volunteer drivers and is for hire by any of the small groups in Burnley, Pendle and Rossendale.
