

LancsCAN is applying for £1.5million from the National Lottery's Climate Action Fund (CAF) for a 4-year local communities based project - Lancashire Together: People-**Powered Climate Action** – that would start in later this year.

Its MAIN GOAL is to empower local people and communities in especially disadvantaged areas of Lancashire to drive forward new inclusive forms of community-based climate action that is lasting, impactful and resilient. We will bring together people and skills to affect real change, driven by communities and for communities, to work collaboratively on what they commonly care about, to deliver people-powered climate action in bold, inspiring and creative ways. The project's **FOUR main activity** parts are outlined below.

Lancashire **Together: People-Powered Climate Action!**

A project that needs your feedback and ideas!

What is the Lancashire Climate Action Network (LancsCAN)?

Established in June 2023, we are a network of 190+ communityoriented member organisations working on various climate action fronts across the county.

(1) CLIMATE JURIES (First, getting local people together)

A climate jury brings together a cross-section of people from a local community to explore what their everyday experiences and interests are relating to climate change, and then actions to take. We are planning SIX 'local neighbourhood' Climate Juries in certain 'disadvantaged' areas of Lancashire (tbc) and TWO 'youth' Climate Juries. These will take place in the project's first phase and enable us to better identity and understand how people from these areas feel about climate change and explore what actions they could take to help address it, both individually and collectively.

(3) COMMUNITY HUBS

(Creating places where people work together)

Following outcomes of (1) and (2), Community Hubs would be created for wider participation of people to work together on their own climate action ideas for activity, as well as receive training and develop new skills. These would be located in the six Climate Jury neighbourhoods but with other Community Hubs also formed elsewhere in Lancashire, including where existing community hubs of sorts already exist that the project could further develop. (2) COMMUNITY ORGANISING (Creating communities for action and influence)

Community organising brings people together to take action around common concerns and affect social change. Our Project will employ a local fulltime Community Organiser to work with diverse communities on shared climate concerns, and (further) develop and train local leaders to address them. Working in conjunction with the Climate Juries but across the wider county, our Community Organising will build and deepen relationships among the Lancashire public, laying foundations for new people-powered climate actions in everyday lives.

FOUR main activity parts

(4) CLIMATE VENTURES (Turning ideas into people-powered activities)

The project's Climate Ventures will turn people's *ideas on climate action* arising from (1), (2) and (3) into new activities, these mainly located at the Community Hubs. To help get things started, LancsCAN member organisations have proposed ideas on possible activities, such as: Nature and Health; Transport and Cycling; Food, Sustainability and Health; Housing and Energy; Arts, Culture and Performance. The project could start-up any Climate Venture activity, though, that people are interested in developing!



Learning and Sharing

Supported by others, there will be opportunities to learn new interesting things and share these and your own ideas and interests with others.

Improve the World Around You

We may not be able to change the whole world but we can help change the world in which we live locally, in our own community. The project would empower you to do so.

New Skills and Training

By being involved in the project, you would have a range of opportunities to receive training and develop new skills in your areas of interest on local climate action.

Be Part of Something Bigger

We want to create new groups and communities of local climate action in Lancashire, where people do not feel alone or isolated but instead part of something bigger in unison with others.
