The Maden Family Hub

On the 29th of September 2023, The Children and Family Wellbeing Service, alongside partner organisations had the pleasure of launching Rossendale's first Family Hub at the Maden Centre in Bacup. The day was supported by Britannia school children who came along to sing their school song. 40 plus partners joined the launch which proved to be a great success. Families came along to join in craft and games activities. The Oral Health Team offered advice on toothbrushing and provided toothbrushes and toothpaste along with other free gifts. Mental health services and the NHS Health service were available to give advice on a range of issues, including infant feeding, chat to a Health Visitor, and have a health check. Citizen's Advice were available to offer advice and guidance on a range of issues. Adult learning and Home-Start were just a few of the services in attendance. This proved to be the blueprint for our next launch which was in March 2024 at Haslingden Community link.

Another successful Launch, again supported by a range of partners including GP Practices, who were on hand to discuss the importance of vaccinations for children and to dispel any myths that may concern parents. The afternoon was busy with lots of activities and this time we were treated to a performance from the Rossendale Ukulele Band. Rawtenstall Family Hub and The Zone

The launch for the Family Hub and Zone at Rawtenstall was included as part of the Family Fun and HAF program, over the Easter break families enjoyed lots of fun activities with an Easter theme and for our older children and young people there was a Climbing wall, Bushcraft and Archery. Information about partners organisations and the services they offer was available for families.

We will work with victims and their families to secure the safety of those affected by domestic abuse and support their development so that each individual is helped to grow and fulfil their potential into the future.
