**“I’ve got my confidence and independence back.”**

## Reason For referral

Client referred to Social Prescribing service by GP surgery. Recently registered as partially sighted, felt lost confidence and independence. Feeling much more socially isolated, which is impacting mood.

## Initial Assessment and Support Provided

Currently volunteers at a charity shop usually once a week but sometimes twice a week.

Used to attend Crafty Minds card making group at Burnley Library but didn't feel like she connected with the people.

Signposted to Park Social, info given for seated exercise at Prairie, St Catherines' craft group and BFC Extra Time. Client is keen to try Park Social to begin with.

Supported in accompanying to Park Social group.

## Background of Client

Unable to participate in hobbies which she used to enjoy such as crafts.

Volunteers in a local charity shop but finding this more difficult.

## Client Outcomes

Regularly attends Park Social group on a weekly basis.

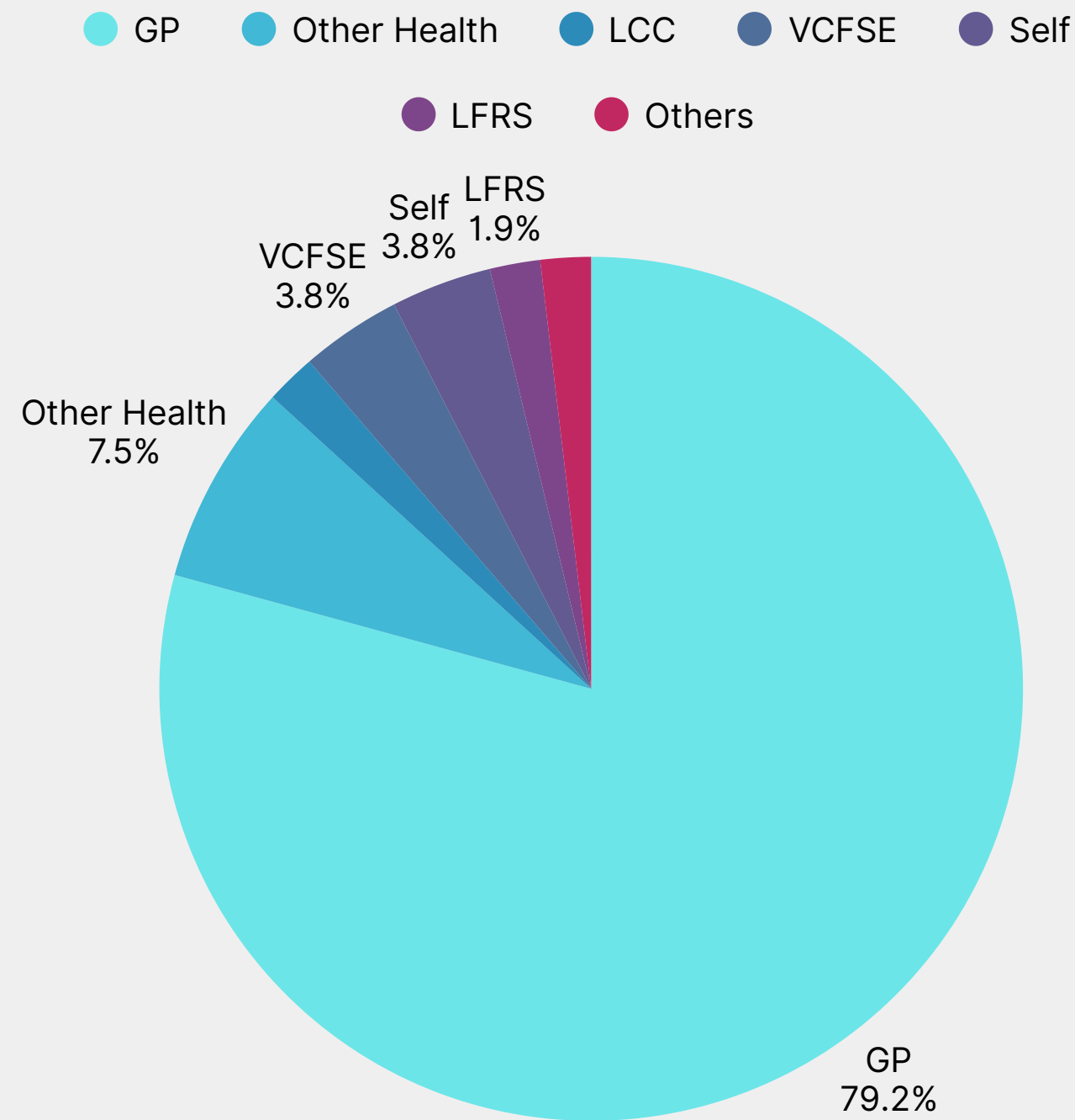

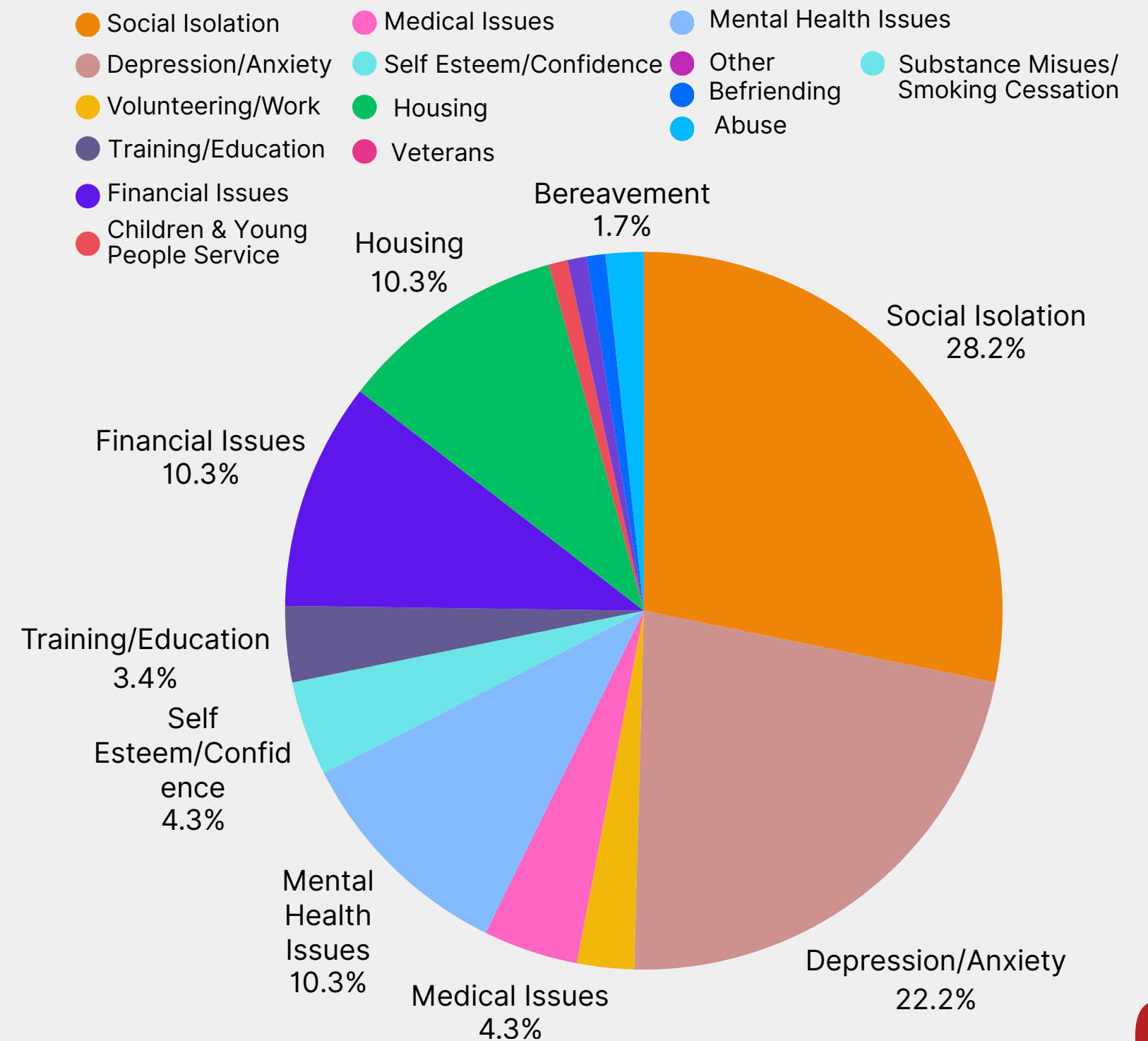
